

## Hans-Christian Euler

Conductor and Director

Hans-Christian Euler studied violin in Hannover and London. In 1981 he was a founding member in the Orchestra of the 18th Century Amsterdam, since 1983 he has been playing in "Niedersächsisches Staatsorchester Hannover".

In 1987 he took over a teaching assignment in the "Hochschule für Musik, Theater und Medien Hannover" and became 1994 artistic director of "Ensemble Musica Viva Hannover".

Hans-Christian Euler gave concerts and masterclasses in European countries, in Israel, Australia and China.

2005 Hans-Christian Euler founded the music-society "Nordstadt-Konzerte" in Hannover and is now conductor of "Hannover Chamber Orchestra". As a specialist in historically informed performance practice as well as in contemporary music he has been particularly interested in creating unusual programs.

He appeared in various festivals, e.g. Festwochen Herrenhausen, Festival Musik 21 Niedersachsen, Klangbrücken Hannover, Aujourd'hui musique Perpignan, Festival de la Normandie, Bologna-Festival, Mozart-Festival Poznań, Daegu International Contemporary Music Festival and Tongyeong International Music Festival 2018.

In October 2020 he was decorated in South Korea with a UNESCO Creative City of Music Award 2020 in recognition for his Eurasia Festival.
